In this petition, the petitioner is challenging the judgment dated 13.01.2021 passed by the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohtak, whereby, a sum of Rs.6,000/- per month as maintenance from the date of the petition i.e. from 03.07.2017 and Rs.11,000/- as litigation expenses has been awarded in favour of the respondent-wife.

2. Notice of motion in the present petition was issued on 20.03.2024 and the petitioner did not file the process fee. Vide order dated 25.07.2024, again learned counsel for petitioner expressed regret for the aforesaid lapse and undertook to file the process fee in the Registry within one week. However, as per the office report till date, the process fee has not been filed.

3. In light of the above, this Court is left with no other choice but to dismiss the present petition for non-prosecution.
