Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 18.3.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-7393-2025 titled as “Neeru Rani vs. State of Haryana and others”, vide which, the petition was disposed of on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the respondents-State “...that the pending representation, dated 11.5.2024, will be decided by the second respondent/Director, Higher Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks...” and “...In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of Rs.50,000/- to the petitioner.”



Learned counsel for the respondent-State has filed the Compliance Report dated 27.5.2025 by way of affidavit of Shri S. Narayanan, IFS, Director General Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula and submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing a speaking order dated 20.5.2025 by the respondent; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid Compliance Report dated 27.5.2025 alongwith the Speaking Order (Annexure R-1) annexed with the application, produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State are taken on record. Copies thereof are supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the above, the present petition may be disposed of.
