1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to keep departmental proceedings in abeyance till the conclusion of proceedings emanating out of FIR No.49 dated 18.10.2024, under Section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

2. Mr. Sahil Kumar, Advocate for the petitioner submits that respondents may be directed not to proceed with departmental proceeding till the filing of police report under Section 173 of Cr.P.C.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab concedes that this Court in similar cases has directed to keep the departmental proceedings in abeyance till the filing of police report.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with aforesaid statement.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent to keep the departmental proceedings in abeyance till the date of filing challan in aforesaid FIR.
