Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in partial compliance of the order passed by the respondents dated 01.04.2014, some payments have been released to the petitioner but the arrears as per entitlement of the petitioner have not been paid *in toto*.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to file a detailed representation highlighting therein the amount which the petitioner is entitled to, the payment of amount which has not been released to him. The said representation will be filed within four weeks.

In case the petitioner files such representation to respondents No.3 and 4, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents within a period of six weeks of submission of such representation. In case the claim is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within further period of six weeks.
