By way of the present writ petition, the petitioners have sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to decide the representations dated 06.05.2024/07.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) regarding the allotment of proper place to the petitioners to run their respective business as Scrap Dealers.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that with regard to their grievance, the petitioners have already made representations dated 06.05.2024/07.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) to the competent authority, but no action has been taken

thereon till date.

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Sanjeev Ghai, Advocate is present in the Court. Learned counsel for the respondent-UT Chandigarh submits that the said representations shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents, to look into the pending representations dated 06.05.2024/07.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioners and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.
