Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent for not complying the order dated 24.7.2025 (Annexure P-2) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-39345-2025 titled as “Sheetal Sharma vs. State of Punjab and others”, whereby the petition was disposed of and a direction was issued to respondents No.2 and 3 therein “....to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner expeditiously and within a time bound manner, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.”

At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that the order dated 24.7.2025 (Annexure P-2) has been complied with and a Speaking Order dated 22.9.2025 has been



passed by the respondent-authority; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid order dated 22.9.2025 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the said fact and admits that the order dated 24.7.2025 (Annexure P-2) has been complied with and a Speaking Order dated 22.9.2025 has been passed by the respondent-authority. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the said position, the present contempt petition may be disposed of accordingly.

In view of the above noted facts and the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition stands **disposed of** accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
