HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head of the Department submits that the petitioners shall be released their benefits under orders passed by the Writ Court which was upheld in an intra-Court appeal; within two months from today. He also submits that wherever an employee was recruited prior to 17.07.2020, he shall be accorded benefits in terms of notification dated 05.07.2021 within the afore-stated period.

In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition, however it is made clear that in case the respondents fail to do the needful in terms of aforesaid undertaking, the salary of respondent Nos.1 and 2 shall remain attached till the compliance is made.

Rule discharged.

Keeping in view the undertaking extended by the respondents, the payment of cost is deferred and in case the aforesaid undertaking is not complied with, the order dated 06.03.2025 passed by this Court imposing cost(s) of Rs.5,000/- to be paid to each of the petitioners shall automatically stand revived.
