The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to promote the petitioner as TGT Science from the date his juniors were promoted vide order dated 14.10.2024, Annexure P-9, and grant him all consequential benefits along with arrears of pay with interest at the rate of twelve per cent per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 20.10.2024, Annexure P-10, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rohit Arya, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 20.10.2024, will be decided by respondent no.2/Director General, Elementary Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
