1. The present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0023 dated 08.05.2025 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 108, 56, 74, 85, 3(5) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station GRP Bathinda, District Government Railway Police.

3. In furtherance to the order dated 12.08.2025 passed in the connected petition i.e. CRM-M-38834-2025, the parties along with their son were referred to the mediation. As per the report of the Mediator, the parties have amicably resolved the matter and have agreed to part ways.

4. In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated

23.06.2025 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 482 of BNSS, 2023.

5. However, nothing stated above shall be construed as a final expression of opinion on the merits of the case and this order shall not be considered as parity qua any other co-accused.

6. It is made clear that, in case, the petitioner is found involved in any such activity once again, the present concession so granted shall automatically stand vacated.

7. It is further made clear that the parties shall remain bound by their obligations as agreed upon by them in the settlement.

8. Pending miscellaneous application(s) shall stand disposed of.
