Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for violation of the order dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-20966-2022 titled as "Rajeshwar and others vs. State of Haryana and others".

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as a Speaking Order has been passed by the respondents on 28.4.2025, which has been conveyed to the petitioner only on the last night.

Learned counsel for the State has handed over photocopy of the said Speaking Order dated 28.4.2025 in the Court, which is taken on record. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place



in the paper book. Learned counsel for the State informs that vide said Speaking Order the objections of the petitioner have been dismissed.

Therefore, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the present petition may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the aforesaid Speaking Order dated 28.4.2025 as per law.
