1. Learned counsel for the revision petitioner after arguing the matter for some time has submitted that his interest would be met, in case, the learned Appellate Court is directed to hear the arguments on 09.10.2025, for which the appeal is pending for arguments.

Now, considering the fact that the learned First Appellate Court has stayed the execution of the decree and there are orders dated 20.09.2025 showing that none appeared for the appellant, again on 24.09.2025, none was present for the appellant and on 25.09.2025, a new counsel put in appearance on behalf of the appellant and there is an interim order in favour of the appellant, which is causing prejudice to the rights of the petitioner, as such, the learned First Appellate Court is requested to dispose of the appeal within a period of one month from the date next fixed before the Court and petition is disposed of accordingly.
