Learned counsel for the parties agreed that as per notice at page No. 51, first four claims of the petitioner (there are four claims but since claim No. 3 is missing, they go up to claim No. 5) now stands satisfied. The petitioner submits that claims No. 6 to 9 require adjudication while submission of learned counsel for the respondents is that they are 'excepted matters'. It is also pointed out that what is called the supplementary agreement dated 07.08.2012 had only an endorsement of the petitioner towards full and final settlement of measurements and thus measurements are not in question.

In view of the aforesaid position, it is agreed that Justice Permod Kohli, retired Chief Justice of Sikkim High Court, be appointed as sole Arbitrator to settle the remaining disputes *inter-se* the parties. The fee of the Arbitrator will be as per the Punjab and Haryana High Court (Arbitrators Panel and Fee) Rules, 2011.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

A copy of the order be sent to the Arbitrator.
