**VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)**

1. On 11.01.1995, a Coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

*“Present: Mr. P. S. Kadian, DAG, Haryana for the appellant.  
Mr. Vikas Singh, Advocate for the respondent.*

*After hearing learned counsel for the parties, I am of the view that no case is made out for staying the execution proceedings. Admittedly, the scheme came to an end on 28.2.1990 and the learned counsel for the plaintiff-respondent concedes that the plaintiff is not entitled to wages for the period subsequent to 28.2.1990, i.e. the date of closure of the scheme. In the situation, amount of salary if deposited with the executing court be disbursed to the plaintiff-respondent, provided she furnishes a bank guarantee to the satisfaction of the executing court along with an undertaking that in the event of the present appeal being allowed, she will refund the amount of salary that may be disbursed to her by the executing court. Bank guarantee shall be accepted after notice to the appellants.*

*Civil Misc. stands disposed of accordingly.*

2. Apparently, the dispute in the present case is only with respect to the period from 22.08.1988 to 28.02.1990.

3. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for the respondent have jointly submitted that in view of the above, present appeal be disposed of at this stage but liberty be granted to the parties, in case, any cause of action survives.
