

POONAM V/S JOGINDER SINGH AND ORS

Present: None.

The present application was filed in the year 2024 wherein, the objection was raised by the Registry. Thereafter, none had bothered to clear the said objection and the incomplete application is still pending with the Registry of this Court.

As per Rule 9, Chapter I, Part-A, Volume V of the Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the application on which some objection is raised by the Registry, the same is required to be taken back by the counsel/party, who filed it, to be re-filed within a total period of 40 days. However, the same was never taken back for the purposes of re-filing and thus, the case is listed before this Court for orders.
