RUPINDERJIT CHAHAL, J. (Oral)

1. This is a petition filed under Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.64 dated 08.06.2025 registered under Sections 281 & 125 of BNS 2023 at Police Station Division 7, Commissionerate Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 24.06.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. This Court vide order dated 30.07.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 19.09.2025 to the effect that the compromise



has been effected between the parties is voluntary, without any threat, fear or coercion from any corner.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.64 dated 08.06.2025 registered under Sections 281 & 125 of BNS 2023 at Police Station Division 7, Commissionerate Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/settlement dated 24.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) are quashed.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand(s) disposed of, accordingly.
