1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.51 dated 28.03.2025 under Section 318(4) of the BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Rural).

2. On 09.07.2025, following order was passed:-

“The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.51 dated 28.03.2025 under Section 318(4) of the BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Rural).

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has not disputed that there is no documented monetary transactions between the petitioner and the complainant. It has also not been disputed that although earlier an FIR was registered against the petitioner under Section 420 IPC, however, the same has since been quashed by this Court vide order dated 25.09.2023.

Adjourned to 18.09.2025.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and appear before the investigating agency, as and when called upon to do so. In the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.”

3. Today, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 09.07.2025 and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 09.07.2025, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.

5. Disposed of.

6. Pending misc application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
