This is an application under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 for appointment of Arbitrator.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents raises a preliminary objection to the effect that the matter involves an international commercial arbitration and therefore, an application for appointment of an Arbitrator can only be made in the Supreme Court of India.

3. The petitioner is a company incorporated outside India. The petition is, therefore, dismissed only on this ground with liberty to the petitioner to adopt appropriate proceedings.

In view of this order, it was not necessary to grant time to the respondent for filing an affidavit on any other grounds.
