SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

1. Present appeal has been filed by the appellants, challenging the order dated 03.01.2025, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad, whereby anticipatory bail application filed by the appellants, in case bearing FIR No.300, dated 03.06.2024, under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC and (Section 325 IPC, 3(1)(s), 3(2va)/33/89 of the SC/ST Act, 1989 added later on), registered at Police Station Kotwali, Faridabad, has been dismissed.

2. On 15.01.2025, following order was passed:-

“1. Present appeal has been filed by the appellants, challenging the order dated 03.01.2025, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad, whereby anticipatory bail application filed by the appellants, in case bearing FIR No.300, dated 03.06.2024, under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC and (Section 325 IPC, 3(1)(s), 3(2va)/33/89 of the SC/ST Act, 1989 added later on), registered at Police Station Kotwali, Faridabad, has been dismissed.

2. While relying upon the order dated 14.01.2025 passed by this Court in the anticipatory bail petition of co-accused namely Sumit, in regard to the role attributed to the appellants, counsel for the



appellants submits that appellant No.1 – Rahul Singh has been attributed with causing the grievous injury falling under Section 325 I.P.C., appellant No.2 – Harsh has been attributed with the role of giving Danda blow resulting into causing a simple injury, and petitioner No.3 – Sagar Singh has been attributed with the role of pelting the stones.

3. *Further submits that all the injuries except one, are simple in nature. Even offence pertaining to the grievous injury, is bailable in nature.*

4. *Notice of motion.*

5. *On advance notice, Mr. Kanwar Sanjiv Kumar, AAG, Haryana, puts an appearance on behalf of the respondent/State.*

6. *List again on 05.03.2025, to enable learned State counsel to file status report in the matter.*

7. *In the meanwhile, the appellants namely Rahul Singh, Harsh and Sagar Singh are directed to join the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Agency. In the event of their arrest, they shall be released on ad-interim bail, subject to their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. The appellants shall also abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023.*

8. *Besides, appellants would submit/surrender their passport before the Arresting Officer and an undertaking on oath that in case of leaving the country, they would seek prior permission from the Investigating Agency/concerned Court.”*

3. Learned counsel for the appellants contends that in compliance of the order dated 15.01.2025, passed by this Court, the appellants have joined the investigation, and have fully co-operated.

4. Learned State counsel has filed status report in the Court today and the same is taken on record, and on instructions from SI Dinesh Kumar, confirms the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the appellants would not be required now for the purpose of investigation.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. Since the appellants have joined the investigation and custodial interrogation is no more required, coupled with the reason that despite service of notice upon respondent Nos.2 and 3, none has put an appearance on behalf of them, present appeal is allowed and ad-interim order dated 15.01.2025 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute.

However, appellants shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the terms and conditions laid down under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

7. Accordingly, appeal stands disposed of.
