**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 02.08.2018 (Annexure P-5) whereby respondent has kept their claim in abeyance. They are further seeking direction to respondent to fill up the post of Tutors by promoting them in compliance of directions of Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench.



2. Mr. Sanjiv Gupta, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that by impugned order the respondent has observed that Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh has already moved a proposal to Administrator to merge the College of Nursing as part and parcel of Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh so that there will be a common cadre. The matter is pending before Administrator though a substantial period has passed away. The grievance of petitioner would be redressed if U.T. Administration is directed to consider case of petitioners in the light of observations in the impugned order.

3. Mr. Parminder Singh Kanwar, Addl. Standing Counsel for U.T. Administration submits that matter with respect to merger of Nursing College with Government Medical College & Hospital is pending before Chief Secretary.

4. Without commenting on merits and to resolve the dispute, I deem it appropriate to direct the Chief Secretary, U.T. Administration, Chandigarh to look into the matter and decide the issue of merger in principle. Let the needful be done within 3 months from today.
