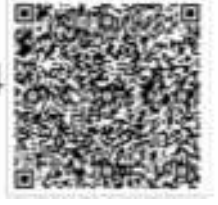

The learned Amicus Curiae, at the very outset, submits that earlier, some co-accused of the present petitioner-Happy Jain, have approached this Court seeking quashing of the FIR No.39 dated 26.01.2016 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 201, 120-B IPC and Sections 7/13/49 of the PC Act, registered at Police Station City Jind and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom. He has placed on record separate copies of the orders passed in the respective petitions whereby the petitions bearing No.CRM-M-24963-2020 titled as 'Sandeep Dulhan and another versus State of Haryana' and CRM-M-No.16811-2023 'titled as Manoj and another versus State of Haryana' came to be dismissed vide orders dated 17.09.2020 and 06.09.2023 whereas the petition bearing No.CRM-M-8026-

2021 titled as 'Hitender Kumar versus State of Haryana' came to be dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 22.02.2021 and a petition bearing No.CRR-815-2020 titled as 'Sushil Bansal and another versus State of Haryana' was dismissed for non-prosecution with a direction to the Trial Court to expedite the Trial vide order dated 19.10.2023.

2. Faced with this situation, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the grounds as raised in the present petition before the Trial Court at the appropriate stage.
