1. Prayer in the instant petition, filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C., is for issuance of direction for the inquiry from Central Bureau of Investigation in the matter.
2. Perusal of the record would show that the present case has a chequered history as initially in the complaint filed by the petitioner in the year 2015 before the police, no cognizable offence was found to have been made out. Thereafter, the petitioner filed a petition under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. dated 07.05.2016 for registration of a criminal case under Sections 406, 414, 418, 420, 421, 422, 463 and 120-B IPC but the same was ordered to be treated as a private complaint by the learned JMIC, Chandigarh vide its order dated 18.07.2016. Thereafter, on examination of the material on record and the evidence recorded, learned JMIC, Chandigarh dismissed the said private

complaint vide its order dated 03.02.2018. The said order was assailed by the petitioner before this Court by way of filing CRM-M-20215-2019 but this Court also dismissed the same vide order dated 20.09.2019. The petitioner further challenged the order dated 20.09.2019 passed by this Court before the Supreme Court by way of filing SLP (CrI.) No.011609/2019, which was also dismissed by the Supreme Court vide order dated 06.01.2020.

3. Thus, since the grievance raised by the petitioner had already been appreciated even up to the Supreme Court, therefore, nothing survives in the present petition warranting interference by this Court and hence, the same is hereby dismissed.
