1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 21.06.2022, in CWP-13683-2022.
2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 21.06.2022, reveals that CWP-13683-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide legal notice/representation served by the petitioner as expeditiously as possible.
3. At the outset, learned DAG, Haryana, states that claim of the petitioner as contained in representation/legal notice served by the petitioner has been decided vide order Annexure R/1 dated 08.09.2022, therefore, in the circumstances, the instant petition is liable to be disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
4. Reply is stated to have already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. However, none is present on behalf of the petitioner.

5. I have considered the submissions of learned DAG, Haryana and am of the considered view that in the circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by adjourning the petition as admittedly, decision has been taken on the claim of the petitioner as contained in the representation/legal notice.

6. In view of the position noted above, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent(s) under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
