1. The instant petition has been filed for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for alleged non-compliance of the order dated 19.05.2025 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Writ Court in CWP-14475-2025.

2. Short reply already filed by way of compliance affidavit dated 13.08.2025 of the respondent is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the opposite side. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent submits that the respondent has passed a revised speaking order dated 11.08.2025 (Annexure R-1) and as per which, the total retirement dues to the tune of Rs.34,94,373/- have already been paid to the petitioner.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition, but seeks liberty to claim interest having not been granted by laying challenge to the aforesaid revised speaking order.
