Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr. PC seeking quashing of the FIR (Annexure P-1), and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the FIR in question was registered by the complainant on 01.09.2021 and thereafter, the marriage of the petitioner with the daughter of the complainant had taken place, as per Annexure P-2. He
