This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution Of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated 6.4.2018 (P-4) by which respondent no.3 has issued directions to respondent no.4 to appoint the petitioner through private agency and further a writ in the nature of mandamus be issued that the petitioner be not replaced by fresh contract employee.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from Prashant Kumar, Executive Engineer, Sonipat submits that there is no proposal as on date to remove the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner will not be replaced with any other contractual employee except by regular appointment and the case of the petitioner will be considered in light of the The Haryana Contractual Employees

(Security of Service) Act, 2024 subject to the condition that the petitioner shall get himself registered in the Haryana Kaushal Rojgar Nigam.

In light of the above, learned Senior Counsel left has no cause of action to proceed in the matter.

Hence, the petition stands disposed of with above said observations.
