1 The only grievance, at this stage, which propelled the present petitioner, to approach this Court by casting instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is the indolent and lackadaisical approach of the respondents, in not taking a final decision on his various complaints/demand notices (Annexures P-3 to P-6).

2. This Court vide order dated 11.08.2025, had passed the hereinafter extracted order:-

“At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the limited prayer of the petitioner is that respondent No.4, be directed to conclude the proceedings initiated in pursuance of the complaints dated 24.07.2025 (Annexure P-4); 31.07.2025 (Annexure P-5); and 01.08.2025 (Annexure P-6), as submitted by the petitioner.

Without issuing a formal notice, at this stage, learned State counsel is directed to have apt instructions from respondent No.4, and inform this Court, as to how much time is required by the

authorities concerned, to take a final decision on the complaints (supra).

Adjourned to 18.08.2025”

3. In deference to the directions (*supra*), learned State counsel after having instructions from the quarter concerned, informs this Court that the conciliation proceedings have been held in the instant matter. He further informs that all the complaints/demand notices (*supra*), would be decided by the authority concerned, i.e. respondents no.3 to 5., within a period of four weeks from the date of this order.

4. In view of the above specific undertaking taken by learned State Counsel, no further direction is required to be passed, in the instant matter. Consequently, the instant petition is **closed**.

5. **Disposed of** accordingly.
