The petitioner has approached this Court seeking directions to the respondents to grant annual increments in accordance with law as granted to similarly situated employees namely Dr. Mahesh Kumar Narang working as Consultant at DCH Rewari.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-Director General, Health Services, Panchkula is directed to decide the representation dated 31.01.2025 (Annexure P-10) and the grievance espoused by the petitioner therein by passing a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

4. Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana appears on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and No.2-Director General, Health Services, Panchkula, is directed to decide representation dated 31.01.2025 (Annexure P-10) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner is established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of two months.
