Learned State counsel on instructions from Dr. Vinesh Kumar,SDM, Ambala Cantt. submits that upon remand, the case was assigned to him on 28.01.2025 and the same is listed for 18.02.2025 for service upon the parties. The Officer also submits that on account of ensuing municipal elections in the State, he would not be able to hear the matter till 12.03.2025 but assures that the proceedings shall be concluded within a period of two months thereafter.

In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Rule discharged.

However, it is made clear that since the remand order was passed by the Court of Divisional Commissioner, Ambala Division on 19.12.2023, however, the proceedings have not culminated so far, in case, the Officer concerned fails to comply with the undertaking extended by him with respect disposal of the petition within 2 months w.e.f. 12.03.2025, his salary shall remain attached till the final disposal of the case by him.
