The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 18.04.2018 vide which a direction was issued to Sr. Superintendent of Police to go into the grievance of the petitioner after hearing him and to take action as warranted by law.

Reply by way of affidavit of the S.S.P. was filed way back on 03.10.2018. It is evident from the affidavit as well as Annexure R-1 placed on record alongwith the affidavit that similar complaint dated 10.07.2017 had already been inquired into and the report was sent to the senior officers on 03.08.2017 vide which it came into light that the petitioner, who was a terminated employee of Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court on the post of driver visited U.T. Secretariat Sector-9 Chandigarh to meet the then Chief Justice of India but since there was no schedule for public meeting, the petitioner was taken to Police Station Sector-3 for verification in view of his insisting to meet the Chief

Justice of India. He was never kept in custody. The allegations were found to be incorrect.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.
