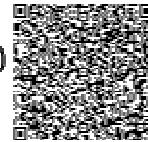

**SUBHAS MEHLA, J. (Oral)**

1. The instant petition has been filed for quashing of impugned order dated 02.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person in FIR No.60 dated 03.04.2020 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court has quashed the order dated 02.07.2024 in CRM-M-40328-2025 filed by the co-accused who is on same footing. A copy of this order be placed in this file.
3. Notice of motion.



4. Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and does not dispute the fact that the case of the petitioner is on same footing with co-accused.

5. Heard.

6. Keeping in view the fact that the present petitioner and the co-accused are declared proclaimed person vide order dated 02.07.2024. The proceedings has been quashed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 30.07.2024 in CRM-M-40328-2025. The case of the present petitioner is on same footing. So the proceedings against him is also quashed and the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and apply for regular bail. In case, such an application for bail is moved by the petitioner before the learned trial Court, the same shall be considered on the same date and decided in accordance with law.

7. However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner does not abide by the aforesaid undertaking, the respondent/State shall be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of the instant petition.

8. The aforesaid order/concession to the petitioner shall be subject to payment of Rs.15,000/- as compensatory penalty to be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority-Disaster Relief Fund, Account No.44426937384, IFSC Code- SBIN0014656, State Bank of India, Sector-68, SAS Nagar (Punjab) and a receipt of the same be produced before the Trial Court and only in that eventuality, application of the petitioner for seeking bail be considered and decided on the same day in accordance with law.



9. The amount so deposited by the petitioner shall not be construed as cost for this order but compensatory penalty for stalling the court proceedings by evading himself from trial for a long time.

10. The instant petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
