Present Writ Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.3 to convert plot No.46, measuring 4050.393 square meters situated in Dhauj crushing zone Faridabad into industrial plot, in compliance of the letter dated 17.03.2020 (Annexure P-16) sent by the Administrator, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran to respondent No.3.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner may be granted liberty to move a representation, for redressal of its grievance, to respondent No.3 and the same be decided, expeditiously.

3. On the other hand, on advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Ankur Mittal, Additional AG Haryana with Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG Haryana for the respondent – State, and Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate, Ms. Saanvi Singla,

Advocate and Ms. Sharni Dadhwal, Advocate for the respondent – HSVP appears and opposes issuance of notice of motion. He does not oppose the prayer of the petitioner and submits that grievance of the petitioner will be looked into by respondent No.3 in case a representation is moved and respondent No.3 shall take decision either way, on such representation.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to make a representation, for redressal of its grievance, before respondent No.3. In case, any such representation is filed by the petitioner, then the same shall be considered and decided, in accordance with law, by respondent No.3 preferably within a period of 04 weeks from the date of filing of such representation.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
