1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.01 dated 08.01.2025 registered under Sections 316(2) and 85 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Women Police Station, District SAS Nagar.
