1. The present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.209 dated 08.10.2024, under Sections 406 and 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar Commissionerate .

2. Vide order dated 15.01.2025, the Coordinate Bench while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Surjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

4. In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated

15.01.2025 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) of the BNSS, 2023.

5. However, nothing stated above shall be construed as a final expression of opinion on the merits of the case and this order shall not be considered as parity qua any other co-accused.

6. It is made clear that, in case, the petitioner is found involved in any such activity once again, the present concession so granted shall automatically stand vacated.
