In this petition, petitioners have prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the transfer letter bearing No.22121/IND-12/CIA-II dated 28.09.2015 (Annexure P-13) and letter bearing No.203962/IND-12/CIA-II/2017 dated 22.06.2017 (Annexure P-14) and letter bearing Memo No.513656/IND-12/CIA-II/2024 dated 22.03.2024 (Annexure P-16) whereby the entire Plot No.12, Industrial Area, Phase-I, Chandigarh has been transferred in favour of respondent No.4 as against the documents on record and as per the judgment rendered

in RSA-820-1996.

2. Mr. Ashish Chopra, Senior Advocate with Mr. Abhishek Kansal and Mr. Varun Aryan Sharma, Advocates, have put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4 and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.

After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition as the issue involved in the present writ petition is purely a question of title between the two parties. He seeks liberty to file a civil suit before the Civil Court with a competent jurisdiction. It is made clear that respondents are free to take all legal objections but such liberty shall not be a direction or extension of any limitation.

4. Without entering into the merits of the case and considering the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
