1. This is a petition for regular bail filed under Section 483 of BNSS for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 5 dated 22.01.2020 under Sections 302 of IPC Act registered at Police Station GRP, District Sangrur.
2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner committed the murder of the brother of the complainant because the brother of the complainant stopped the petitioner from taking motorcycle of someone else.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case as the FIR was registered against the unknown person and the name of the petitioner was nominated in the FIR after a delay of 34 days from the occurrence.
4. Learned State counsel vehemently opposes the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that at the time of occurrence, complainant, was present at the spot and had seen the petitioner committing the murder but he was not aware of the name of the petitioner. He further submits that

all the prosecution witnesses have been examined in this case and the trial is at a fag end and the petitioner is involved in 11 more cases.

5. I have heard the submissions made by the parties and gone through the record.

6. Keeping in view the facts of the case that the allegations against the petitioner are serious and grave in nature; the petitioner is involved in 11 more cases shows that he is a habitual offender and has a criminal antecedents. Considering that the case is at the fag end of trial, no ground is made out to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
