2. The present petition(s) has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-‘BNSS’) for quashing of FIR No.378, dated 10.11.2024 under Sections 115(2), 118(1) and 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (For short “BNS”) as well as GD No.21 dated 18.11.2024 under Sections 324(2), 332(a) and 351(3) of BNS, 2023 in FIR No.378, dated 10.11.2024 under Sections 115(2), 118(1) and 3(5) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexures P-2 & P-3).

3. This Court vide order dated 01.05.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

4. Pursuant to the aforesaid order(s), parties have appeared before the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kharar and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 13.06.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

5. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

6. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

7. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and***

another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, both the petitions are allowed and FIR No.378, dated 10.11.2024 under Sections 115(2), 118(1) and 3(5) of BNS, 2023 as well as GD No.21 dated 18.11.2024 under Sections 324(2), 332(a) and 351(3) of BNS, 2023 in FIR No.378, dated 10.11.2024 under Sections 115(2), 118(1) and 3(5) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexures P-2 & P-3) are quashed qua the petitioners.
