SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 17.12.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-33967-2024.

2. The relevant portion of order dated 17.12.2024 passed by this Court is reproduced as under:-

“In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 15.10.2024, taking note of the above referred judgments, within a period of 3 months. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.”

5. In compliance of the above order, speaking order dated 28.08.2025 has been passed by Addl. Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Home Department. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner. The copy of speaking

6. In view of the above, order dated 17.12.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-33967-2024 has already been complied with, as speaking order dated 28.08.2025 has been passed.

7. Accordingly, the contempt is purged. Rule is *discharged*.
