1. On the last date of hearing i.e.18.09.2025, the following order was passed:-

*“Mr. Shashi Garg appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that the order of status quo has been passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court in SLP (Civil) Diary No.46242-2025, whereby the decision dated 09.04.2025, passed by the larger Bench of this Court in LPA No.1843-2019 (and order dated 05.05.2025 passed in CM-3184-LPA-2025 in LPA-3184-2019) is challenged by the State of Punjab.*

*By way of filing the present petition, the petitioner has alleged non-compliance of the order dated 19.05.2025, passed in CWP-7473-2017 (Annexure P-1) along with the decision in LPA-1843-2019 (Annexure P-2), modified/clarified in CM-3184-LPA-2025 read with decision dated 21.10.2024 in CWP-25480-2017 (Annexure P-4).*

*In view of the order of status quo passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court, no further proceedings can be continued in the present petition.*



*There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.*

*In the interest of justice, adjourned to 22.09.2025.*

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the present petition may be disposed of at this stage with liberty to file an application for revival of the petition in case any grievance would be still left after the decision by the Hon’ble Apex Court.
