1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 483 of B.N.S.S. with a prayer to grant interim regular bail to him for a period of 07 days to attend the wedding of his niece.

2. Mr. Abhinav Gupta, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2-complainant by filing his memo of appearance, which is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the marriage of Nisha and Nikita, nieces of the petitioner is scheduled to be held on 20.04.2025 and 21.04.2025 and the petitioner, being the maternal uncle has to perform certain rituals and ceremonies like *Bhaat*, *Kanya Daan* etc. He

further submits that the *Bhaat* ceremony is fixed to be held on 20.04.2025, whereas the main wedding function is fixed on 21.04.2025.

4. Learned State counsel has filed a status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, C.A.W. & Traffic, District Rewari, Haryana and the same is taken on record. Learned State counsel submits that the facts have been verified and the marriage of Nisha and Nikita, both daughter of Keshari Devi (sister of the petitioner) is to be held on 21.04.2025. He further contends that the petitioner is involved in a serious crime and apart from the present case, he is also involved in 06 other criminal cases. Consequently, the petitioner is a hardened criminal and may not be released on interim bail.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

6. The FIR in the present case was registered under Sections 302, 323, 201 & 34 IPC and serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner. Further, the petitioner is also involved in 06 more criminal cases.

7. Consequently, keeping in view the gravity of the allegations levelled in the present case as well as the involvement of the petitioner in other criminal cases, he cannot be ordered to be released on interim bail. However, the Superintendent of the concerned Jail is directed to take the petitioner in custody to the Venue of the marriages i.e. Jhabharmal Latta Guest House, Behind Pandit Ganesh Naryan Mandir, Chirawa (Rajasthan)

and to permit him to attend the *Bhaat* ceremony between 10:00 A.M to 01:00 P.M on 20.04.2025. Further, the petitioner shall again be taken in custody to the same marriage venue between 09:00 A.M to 11:00 A.M on 22.04.2025.

8. The Superintendent of Police of District Mohindergarh is directed to provide the necessary police help to the Superintendent of the District Prison, Narnaul.
