This is a petition for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.77 dated 17.09.2020, registered under Sections 307/473/506/148/149 IPC and 25 and 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Badhni Kalan District Moga.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case on the basis of disclosure statement suffered by co-accused. It is submitted that earlier the petitioner was granted regular bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Moga, vide

order dated 29.04.2022. However, due to lack of proper advice, he could not attend the proceedings on 28.02.2024 and subsequently was declared as proclaimed offender on 12.09.2024. The absence of the petitioner was not intentional and he himself surrendered before the trial Court on 03.01.2025. It is further stated that the material witnesses have been examined and conclusion of trial will take sufficient time, as such, the petitioner be admitted to bail.

3. Per contra, learned State counsel opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner, on the ground that there are serious allegations leveled against the petitioner.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the facts that the petitioner is in custody since 03.01.2025, the material witnesses have already been examined and conclusion of trial will take sufficient time, as such, the present petition deserves to be allowed. Therefore, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner namely Gagandeep Singh alias Gagna is ordered to be released on regular bail during pendency of the trial, on furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed to be expression of an opinion by this Court on merits of the case. The learned
