By way of present petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, the petitioner has sought issuance of necessary order or direction for respondents No.2 and 3 for stay to conduct multiple enquiries with regard to a false FIR No.54 dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 306 IPC, P.S. Vairoke, District Fazilka.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner having no concern whatsoever with the allegations levelled in the FIR (Annexure P-1), the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that this has been done on the basis of multiple enquiries conducted on the false allegations levelled by the complainant qua which he has already moved representation (Annexure P-10) to respondent No.2 on 02.12.2024. However, no action thereon has been taken till date.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are issued to respondent No.2 to dispose of the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-10) dated 02.12.2024 in accordance with rules in an expeditious manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Singh Bhatta, DAG Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents 1 to 4 and submits that the representation (Annexure P-10) will be disposed of in accordance with rules in an expeditious manner.

6. After hearing the respective submissions and the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-the Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 02.12.2024 (Annexure P-10) and dispose of the same in accordance with the rules in an expeditious manner

7. Decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
