The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for setting aside the order dated 01.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab; order dated 25.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar; order dated 13.05.2011 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Sub Divisional Magistrate, Pathankot (exercising the powers of Collector, Pathankot); and order dated 26.02.2009 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Pathankot.

1.1. A further prayer has been made for setting aside the partition proceedings arising out of partition application (Annexure P-1).

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that various documents like zimni orders passed by the learned Assistant Collector, *Sanad Takseem*, coloured *Aks Shajra*, have inadvertently not been attached in the present writ petition; accordingly, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one with better particulars after attaching all the aforesaid documents in the present writ petition.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
