**SANJAY VASHISTH, J (ORAL)**

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, seeking regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.298 dated 17.12.2023, under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B IPC and Section 82 of Registration Act, 1908 (Sections 467, 468 and 471 IPC were added later on vide order 10.12.2024), registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.

2. Vide order dated 04.12.2024, co-ordinate Bench of this Court granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, and same was continued on the subsequent dates, also.

3. On 11.07.2025, following order was passed by this Court:-

*“1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, seeking regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.298 dated 17.12.2023, under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B IPC and Section 82 of Registration Act,1908 (Sections 467, 468 and*

*471 IPC were added later on vide order 10.12.2024), registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.*

*2. For resolving of the dispute amicably, as then requested by the petitioner, he was released on interim regular bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 04.12.2024. Said order was continued on 28.01.2025, and 10.03.2025. However, upon being apprised on 03.07.2025 that the petitioner, despite giving assurances and availing the benefit of interim regular bail, failed to honour the undertaking given before this Court, the interim protection was not further extended.*

*3. Meaning thereby that interim bail was not extended beyond the period recorded in the order dated 21.04.2025 or at best not beyond 03.07.2025, because on 21.04.2025 petition was not taken up for its hearing. Still petitioner is unable to meet out the purpose for releasing him on interim regular bail, therefore, same is hereby ordered to be cancelled and petitioner is directed to surrender back to the concerned jail immediately without any delay.*

*4. List again on 18.07.2025.”*

4. Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not in a position to inform the Court, whether the petitioner has surrendered to the jail authorities, in compliance with the order dated 11.07.2025 passed by this Court, as no communication has been received from the petitioner despite having sent a notice in this regard.

5. On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions submits, that petitioner has misused the concession of interim bail granted by this Court and has not surrendered, till date.

6. In view of the above, present petition stands **dismissed** with a direction to the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate to issue non-bailable warrants against the petitioner to ensure his re-arrest and to have him lodged back in jail. The Chief Judicial Magistrate is further directed to proceed in accordance with law.
