1 The petitioner has sought the relief for anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of FIR No.15 dated 19.03.2025 under Sections 21, 29, 27-A of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, Tehsil Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.
