1. Learned State counsel has submitted that amended office order no.90 dated 02.09.2025 has been passed by the Divisional Forest Officer, Hisar, a copy of which has been given to this Court, which is taken on record as "Mark A". As per the said order, all the pensionary benefits / retiral benefits which the petitioner is entitled to, have been released. The relevant portion of the said order, which is highlighted, is reproduced hereinbelow:-

*"That it is submitted that on dated 22.08.2025 all the pensionary benefit/ retiral benefits i.e. Gratuity Arrears amounting Rs.78,136/- (Seventy Eight Thousand One Hundard Thirty Six Only) and Regular-Pension Arrears amounting Rs.2,18,143/- (Two Lacs Eighteen Thousand One Hundard*



*Forty Three Only) had already been paid / deposited in the pensionary account of the petitioner on behalf of the above said calculation of days (Annexure A-5).*

*Hence the present amended office order be passed in compliance of the order dated 27.08.2025 passed in abovesaid COCP.*

*I order accordingly.*
