1. The present revision petition has been preferred by the petitioner under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 151 C.P.C. for issuing direction to the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh to decide the execution application bearing No.Civil Misc.185/2024 dated 29.04.2024 titled as *Irina Singh Vs. Sujjan Singh* within a time bound period, as per the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Periyammal (dead) through LRs and others Vs. V. Rajamani and others 2025 INSC 329* and *Rahul S. Shah Vs. Jitendra Kumar Gandhi (2021) 6 SCC 418*.

2. The petitioner, who is appearing in person, submits that she along with her minor daughter were thrown out of the matrimonial home by the respondent-husband and his parents on 04.05.2018. Thereafter, she preferred an application seeking interim maintenance for herself and her minor daughter under Section 18 read with Section 23 of the Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act, 1956 wherein the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh awarded Rs.80,000/- per month to the petitioner and her daughter with effect from the date of order i.e. 14.02.2022, which order was modified by this Court to the extent that the interim maintenance so fixed, shall be payable from the date of filing of the



application and not from the date of passing of the order. On 29.04.2024, the petitioner moved an execution application seeking execution of the order of interim maintenance and for recovery of arrears of Rs.26,55,000/- plus interest @ 5% per annum on the amount of maintenance in case of default of payment of maintenance on 10th of every month. It is further submitted that the aforesaid execution application is pending consideration before the learned Executing Court since 29.04.2024 and therefore, she has sought direction to be issued to the Executing Court to decide the execution application in a time bound manner by placing reliance upon the judgments passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Periyammal (dead) through LRs and others Vs. V. Rajamani and others 2025 INSC 329* and *Rahul S. Shah Vs. Jitendra Kumar Gandhi (2021) 6 SCC 418*.

3. I have heard the petitioner and perused the case file with her able assistance.

4. Keeping in view the fact that the prayer sought by the petitioner is innocuous, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh to decide the execution application bearing No.Civil Misc.185/2024 dated 29.04.2024 titled as *Irina Singh Vs. Sujjan Singh* as expeditiously as possible, keeping in view the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Periyammal (dead) through LRs and others Vs. V. Rajamani and others 2025 INSC 329* and *Rahul S. Shah Vs. Jitendra Kumar Gandhi (2021) 6 SCC 418*.
