1. The plaintiff-appellant had filed the suit for declaration to the effect that the plaintiff is entitled for grant of disability pension. Other prayers were also made in the suit. The said suit was dismissed by the trial Court and the appeal filed by the plaintiff-appellant was also dismissed.
2. A perusal of the paperbook would show that no interim order has been passed in favour of the appellant.
