1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.8, dated 07.01.2025, under Section(s) 15(c), 25, 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar Rural.

2. On 17.07.2025, following order was passed by this Court:-

“As per the allegations and the facts recorded in bail order of co-accused Bir Singh dated 03.04.2025 passed in CRM-M-16876-2025, it is petitioner-Sukhpreet Singh, who was found to be the actual owner of the vehicle in question, i.e., PB08-BR-9311, from which 144 kgs of poppy husk was recovered.

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, in the interest of justice, the matter is adjourned to 18.07.2025.”

3. Today, on the very outset, counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition.

4. Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
