This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking fair and impartial enquiry into the application (Annexure P-1) and take action in accordance with law as per the judgment pronounced by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in 'Lalita Kumari vs. State of UP and another'.
