1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.0104 dated 12.06.2024, under Sections 323, 326, 201, 341,506,148 and 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. While granting the concession of anticipatory bail on 01.05.2025, the following contentions were noticed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the allegations levelled by the complainant in the present case, the petitioner was allegedly carrying a sword and had caused a blow with sword on the head of Bimlesh Kumar, complainant. He further contends that as per the MLR of Bimlesh Kumar, the said injury has been declared to be simple in nature. Rather, all the injuries suffered by Bimlesh Kumar, have been declared to be simple in nature. Learned counsel further submits that in fact, the petitioner had not participated in the

alleged occurrence and had made various representations to the police for fair investigation, however, no heed was paid to these requests”.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner reiterates the above submissions and submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

6. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 01.05.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S.
